Sandy Bulgrin is from Wisconsin. She has been teaching basket weaving for over 38 years, having started by instructing 4- H children, which she continues today. Sandy enjoys teaching at the museums in her area along with many continuing education programs in Wisconsin and Illinois. She has taught at many of the state events, gourd events and retreats. Sandy organizes the Basket Weaving Cruise.

Sandy has created a beautiful designed waste basket for us to weave. Traditional weaving methods are used to complete this basket. The basket starts on an oval wood base and is woven to about 11" high. Using natural and dyed reed students will weave the basket to fit a plastic liner, included. A great basket for bath or office. Dyed reed color choices will be available.

The deadline to order kits is May 10.

Weaving Experience Level: All Levels

Dimensions: 7 1/2" X 11"H

Cost: \$50.00

Tools: water container, spray bottle, pencil, shaver for rim, scissors, towel, clothespins, cable ties and packing tools.

I-39 southbound: South to I-80 east (exit #59). Go 2 miles to exit #81 (Rt. 178, Utica). Go south(right) 3 miles on Rt.178 and follow the signs into the park

I-39northbound: North to exit #48 (Tonica exit). Go east (right) approximately 5 miles to the T intersection, which is Rt.178. Go north(left) for about 5 miles and follow the signs into the Park.

I-80 Eastbound and Westbound: Get off at Exit #81 (Rt.178, Utica). Go south 3 miles on RT 178 and follow signs into the Park.
