Bonnie Rideout created the *Starved Rock 2018 Tote* and *Spirit of Summer* for our 2018 Starved Rock Weave. Double the weaving fun this year!



Starved Rock Tote



Spirit of Summer

The Starved Rock Tote is generous in size and fun to weave. This basket is woven on a 7" x 17" D handle. Techniques include a filled, woven base with dyed filler spokes, triple twine, and weaving a cross-stitch. Accent colors are turquoise and apple green. A pretty metal floral embellishment completes the basket.

- *Starved Rock Tote Basket* dimensions: 9" H (not including the handle) x 14" L x 7 3/4" W.
- Full kits for the *Starved Rock Tote* are \$45; partial kits are \$35. Weaver will need to supply the following items:
 - ✓ SPOKES: 5/8" flat 7 @ 32" (Horizontal); 5/8" flat 8 @ 28" (Vertical)
 - ✓ WEAVERS: #2 round (twining – 1 @ 7" each)
 - ✓ RIM: (2) 5/8 flat oval @ 44" (rim); (1) 7 mm flat @ 44" (rim row); 11/64" flat oval @ 11" (lasher)

Spirit of Summer is woven on a 10" x 14" Quick Weave Handle. Accents for this basket are dyed black reed, wood veneer and jute. A pretty dragonfly compliments this basket. Perfect for summer décor!

- *Spirit of Summer* Dimensions: 10" x 14"
- Full kits for *Spirit of Summer* are \$28; partial kits are not available.

Tools: Water container, spray bottle, sharp scissors, a packing tool, and plenty of clothespins. You will need a scarfing tool for the rim on the *Starved Rock Tote*. Spoke weights are handy for both baskets.

Directions to Starved Rock Lodge



I-39 southbound: South to I-80 east (exit #59). Go 2 miles to exit #81 (Rt. 178, Utica). Go south (right) 3 miles on Rt. 178 and follow the signs into the Park.

I-39 northbound: North to Exit #48 (Tonica exit). Go east (right) approximately 5 miles to the T- intersection, which is Rt. 178. Go north (left) for approximately 5 miles and follow the signs into the Park.

I-80 Eastbound and Westbound: Get off at exit #81 (Rt.178, Utica). Go south 3 miles on Rt. 178 and follow the signs into the Park.
