We are happy to welcome instructor Mary Price of Sunset Ridge Basketry to the Starved Rock Weave in 2025.

The basket Mary will teach is her Royal Jewels Basket. You will learn to create waves of color using eight vibrant jewel tones of dyed flat oval reed on a 10" round slotted wood base. Additionally, students will learn 4-rod wale with a step up, continuous twill weave in natural flat-oval reed, two layers of colorful waves, and finish with a simple folded matchstick rim. During the class, there will be a variety of colors available for selection, in addition to the eight jewel tones provided.

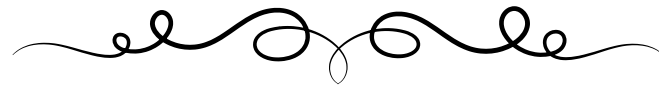


I-39 Northbound: North to exit North to exit #48 (Tonica exit). Go east (right) approximately 5 miles to the T intersection, which is Rt. 178. Go north (left) for about 5 miles and follow the signs into the park.

I-39 Southbound: South to I-80 east (exit #59). Go 2 miles to exit #81 (RT. 178, Utica). Go south (right) 3 miles on Rt. 178 and follow the signs into the park.

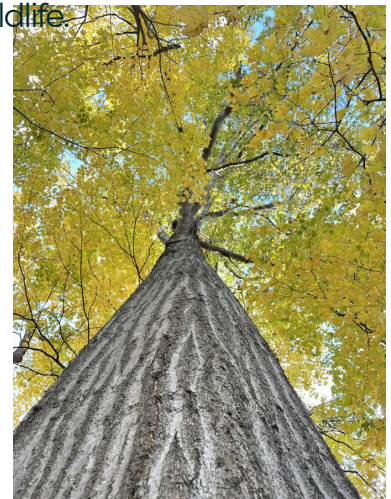
I-80 Eastbound and Westbound: Get off at exit #81 (Rt. 178, Utica). Go south 3 miles on Rt. 178 and follow signs into the park.

Enjoy Beautiful Starved Rock State Park

Starved Rock State Park, nestled along the Illinois River in La Salle County, stands out as one of the most stunning spots in Illinois. Established as the state's second state park in 1911, it boasts 18 canyons with striking vertical walls of moss-laden St. Peter Sandstone, shaped by glacial meltwater over 14,000 years ago. With over 13 miles of trails, visitors can explore rain-fed waterfalls, sandstone overhangs, and breathtaking viewpoints. The park is rich in diverse plant life, including white and red oaks, maples, hickories, white pines, eastern red cedars, and northern white cedars, all of which provide a habitat for a variety of wildlife.
