Registration Information

We have four outstanding teachers offering classes on Friday evening and all day Saturday and Sunday. There is something for everyone and for all weaving levels.

Before you register, please read the class descriptions carefully and pay attention to suggested weaving levels, special tools required, and basket size when making your selections. Classes range from four to eight hours.

Your registration form and class selections must be received by June 24 to be considered as a first day registration.

Many classes will fill on the first day, so don't delay. Please read and carefully follow all instructions on the registration form.

You must be a LLBWA member to register. If you are not currently a member, it's not too late to join. Simply add the \$20 for membership dues to your registration fees.

Registration is \$5 for Friday evening, \$10 for Saturday, \$10 for Sunday, or \$20 for the entire weekend.

Meals will be available at the facility Friday evening as well as Saturday and Sunday afternoon, and must be preordered. Meal information will be forthcoming with your class assignment confirmation packet.

You will receive your class assignment confirmation packet sometime after June 24. The fees for additional kit orders must be returned by July 29.

There will be no cancellations or refunds allowed after August 1st. If you must cancel after this date, you will need to have someone pick up your kit(s) from the teacher(s) at Camp Tuck.

Hotel Information

We have reserved a block of rooms at the following hotel:

Holiday Inn Express & Suites 1715 Parkway Plaza Drive Normal, Illinois 81761 Hotel front desk: 309-862-1600

This is a great location, just off Veterans Parkway, less than 3 miles from the Community Activity Center, and minutes from Eastland Mall and The Shoppes at College Hills. The hotel offers free parking, free Wi-Fi, a free hot buffet breakfast, a refrigerator and there is an elevator in each room. They also have a pool and a hot tub for use after a long day of weaving. We have reserved 15 double rooms and 5 kings at a rate of \$109.00 per night, plus tax. **Reservations will be held until August 19.** After that time, the group rate will not be available.

Please make reservations early, if possible. We have reserved twenty rooms but if demand calls for it and the hotel has availability, we can ask them to add more rooms to our block.

If you need to make a reservation, then need to cancel, there is a Cancellation/Early Departure Policy: Cancels must be made at least 72 hours before the event, in advance. (by 3pm on September 6) Early departure penalty is 50% of the remaining nights.

Weaving Levels

Beginner:

Student has little or no weaving experience with materials or technique used.



Intermediate:

Skilled in basic techniques and materials used. Weaver has no trouble setting up bases, twining, over/under weaves and rims using the material of the class offered.

Advanced:

Mastered all basic and intermediate skills for materials and techniques used. This class is more challenging.

All Levels:

Classes offered to all student skill levels from Beginner to Advanced.

Directions to Community Activity Center

From I-55 Southbound: Take Veterans Parkway Exit 167. Turn left at the stop sign at the end of the ramp. Get in the far right lane and take the Shelbourne/Normal exit on the right. Turn right at the stop sign at the end of the ramp. Continue on Shelbourne to Beech Street. Turn left onto Beech Street and go two blocks. Turn left on Lincoln and then turn left on Cole Street. The parking lot is on the right and the Community Activity Center is on the left.

From I-74 Eastbound: Take Exit 127 toward Chicago and then merge onto I-55 North. Take the N Main St/US 51 S Business Exit 165A toward Bloomington-Normal. Take a left on Raab Road then a right on Linden St. Take a left at Shelbourne Drive then turn right on to Beech St. Turn left on Lincoln St. then left on Cole St. The parking lot is on the right and the Community Activity Center is on the left.

From I-74 Westbound: Take I-55 N/US 51 N. Take the N Main St/US 51 S Business Exit 165A toward Bloomington-Normal. Take a left on Raab Road then a right on Linden St. Take a left at Shelbourne Drive then turn right on to Beech St. Turn left on Lincoln St. then left on Cole St. The parking lot is on the right and the Community Activity Center is on the left.

From I-39 Southbound: Merge onto I-55 N via exit left toward Chicago. Take the N Main St/US 51 S Business Exit 165A toward Bloomington-Normal. Take a left on Raab Road then a right on Linden St. Take a left at Shelbourne Drive then turn right on to Beech St. Turn left on Lincoln St. then left on Cole St. The parking lot is on the right and the Community Activity Center is on the left.

From US 51 Nortbound: Merge onto US 51 N toward Peoria/Rockford and stay straight on I-55 N. Take the N Main St/US 51 S Business Exit 165A toward Bloomington-Normal. Take a left on Raab Road then a right on Linden St. Take a left at Shelbourne Drive then turn right on to Beech St. Turn left on Lincoln St. then left on Cole St. The parking lot is on the right and the Community Activity Center is on the left.

Please Note: There are a limited number of handicapped parking spaces in front of the Activity Center.



Vendor set up time begins Friday, September 9, 2022 at 12:30 pm.



CLASS: NANTUCKET MAPLE BOWL

INSTRUCTOR: Jan Beyma

CLASS LENGTH: 4 Hours WEAVING LEVEL: All

CLASS FEE: \$65

DESCRIPTION: Students will learn to set up and weave a Nantucket using cane stakes and weavers. A basic over under pattern will be woven into the basket. Basket will be finish off with a slip on rim. Base and rim will be pre-finished maple.

Basket will be woven over a plastic mold for class use.

DIMENSIONS: Diameter: 7", Height: 4"

CLASS: TEA BOX

INSTRUCTOR: Annetta Kraayeveld

CLASS LENGTH: 4 Hours WEAVING LEVEL: All levels

CLASS FEE: \$40

DESCRIPTIONS: This beautiful little basket is a perfect hostess gift and a wonderful introduction to weaving with painted paper. Woven with start stop rows woven over a form to aid shaping, then a simple woven embellishment completes the basket. Teacher will provide a wide choice of paper(painted and precut.) SPECIAL TOOLS: Bring sharp scissors, toothless, micro clips, small bent packer and #24 tapestry needle

DIMENSIONS: Width: 2.75" Length: 4.5" Height: 1.75"

CLASS: KNOTTED LEATHER

INSTRUCTOR: Amy Jorgenson

DESCRIPTION: students will start with a 10" wood base, weaving with leather strips and reed up the sides. The middle accent will be a woven leather Celtic knot and finished with bushel handles.

WEAVING LEVEL: All Levels, with weaving experience

DESCRIPTION: Traditional weaving methods are used to create this basket. The basket has an open weave bottom. Shaping is the key to any successfully woven basket and this is no exception. Color choices will be red, white & blue.

DIMENSIONS: 8" Width, 9" Length, 13"Height

CLASS: Nantucket Ditty Bag

INSTRUCTOR: Jan Beyma

CLASS LENGTH: 8 Hours

WEAVING LEVEL: Intermediate

DESCRIPTION: The Nantucket Ditty Bag is woven using cane staves and weavers over a class mold. A combination of traditional and twill weave creates a unique look. Mahogany base and rim are prefinished. Bone knobs, leather handle and choice of liner completes the basket.

CLASS: PERSONALIZED TOTE

DESCRIPTION: Starting with a reinforced woven base, students will weave the tote on a 7 x 21" handle. Then it will be personalized with a 3 initial woven twill insert. Students will email with 3 initials that will be used.

base of the basket(the focal point) consists of 36 twill blocks with six bold colors

The sides continue the twill block pattern using black. Striking! Teacher will provide a wide choice of paper. Hand-painted in bright colors and precut. Twill experience required; paper weaving experience helpful.

SPECIAL TOOLS: Students should bring a #22 tapestry needle, sharp scissors,

several toothless microclips and a small thin packer.

The colors used give the basket an elegant look. It starts with a wooden base and traditional weaving methods are used to create the basket. The slanted weaving is highlighted by using a contrasting color. The only colors available are cocoa and tan.

The slant weaving Is not seen on the inside of the basket.

CLASS: TREVOR'S NANTUCKET SWEET STASH

INSTRUCTOR: Jan Beyma

CLASS LENGTH: 6 HOURS

WEAVING LEVEL: Intermediate

DESCRIPTION: Students will learn to set up a Nantucket. They will also learn to weave a twill into their basket. Basket will be woven with cane staves

and weavers. A slip on rim and lid will finish off the baskets. The base, rim and lid will be Cherry and prefinished. Basket will be woven over a class plastic mold.

DIMENSIONS: Height: 5", Diameter: 4".

CLASS: CORIAN SHADOW

INSTRUCTOR: Amy Jorgenson

CLASS LENGTH: 6 Hours

CLASS FEE: \$65



DESCRIPTION: students will start with corian base on class mold with dyed cane staves. Sides will be chase weave with cane in a twill pattern. Finished with a corian rim and lid.,

DIMENSIONS: Width: 4.5", Height: 4", base: 3"

CLASS: HARLEQUIN TOTE

INSTRUCTOR: Annetta Kraayeveld

CLASS LENGTH: 6 Hours

WEAVING LEVEL: Intermediate

CLASS FEE: \$95



DESCRIPTION: An attractive tote made to hold up for daily use. The basket features two sizes of colorful stakes, start/stop rows, continuous seagrass rows and a lashed rim, finished with red leather handles to accent the stakes. Class will focus on maintaining tension and shaping with uneven stakes. SPECIAL TOOLS: Spoke weight

DIMENSIONS: Width: 8.5", Length: 14", Height: 10"

CLASS: BAY LANE

INSTRUCTOR: Marilyn Wald

CLASS LENGTH: 6 Hours

WEAVING LEVEL: Intermediate

CLASS FEE: \$55



DESCRIPTION: Bay Lane is all about shaping. Beginning with a beginner twill, students will then continue with the natural reed weaving to a slight flare. Shaping and concentration are the key to a fantastic basket with a great shape. There will be a discussion on the handle, the color and fitting the handle to the shape of the basket.

DIMENSIONS: 10" Width, 15" Length, 9" Height, 42", circumference
